Building Industry of Tennessee Hall of Fame

Purpose:

To honor individuals who have made a significant and lasting contribution to housing in Tennessee, the building industry, and the Home Builders Association of Tennessee.

Intent:

In early 1960 a small group of builders convened in Nashville to create the Home Builders Association of Tennessee and to develop a better business atmosphere for home builders throughout the state. Today, we have nearly 3,000 members within a framework of 14 local associations. This is largely due to the efforts of some very special people who have given unselfishly of their time, resources and expertise to establish a viable organization to represent the interests of Tennessee's home building industry.

It is indeed fitting that special recognition be afforded to those association members and others who have in so many ways done so much over the years for the industry and the citizens of Tennessee.

Candidates:

Candidates may be nominated for any one of the following categories **by August 1st**:

- a. **Member Category** – Builder or Associate member of the Home Builders Association of Tennessee, either living or deceased.
- b. **Government Category** – Elected government officials or others in housing's related public service.
- c. **Housing Related Category** – Individuals involved in related fields of endeavor such as financing, planning, architecture, housing research, education and association management

Nominations:

Local home builder associations as well as the state association will have the opportunity to submit their nominee(s) for consideration by the selection committee.

All nominations must be submitted using the official Nomination Form provided by the Building Industry of Tennessee Hall of Fame Selection Committee.

The selection committee may consider a candidate who may not have been nominated by his/her local association. In this event the selection committee would contact the candidate's local association for the appropriate input.

If candidate is an HBAT Past President, candidate is not eligible for induction in the Hall of Fame for at least five (5) years after serving their term in office.

HOF Nominations will follow the same Grand Division rotation as the location of the Fall Board Meeting for the Hall of Fame. For example, if the Fall meeting is in East Tennessee, then the nominated candidate will be from East Tennessee.

Selection Committee

Entries will be judged by the HBAT Past Presidents Committee. If there are not at least seven (7) Past Presidents in the committee meeting, either a conference call is arranged to total seven (7) Past Presidents participating, or no action shall be taken. A conference call will then be scheduled as soon as possible that will include at least seven (7) Past Presidents.

Building Industry of Tennessee Hall of Fame Induction:

Induction ceremonies will be conducted during the Fall Annual Membership Meeting. A formal banquet will be held to honor those selected for induction into the Building Industry of Tennessee Hall of Fame. All inductees will be recognized each year at the HBAT Annual Membership Meeting or other appropriate HBAT function.
